

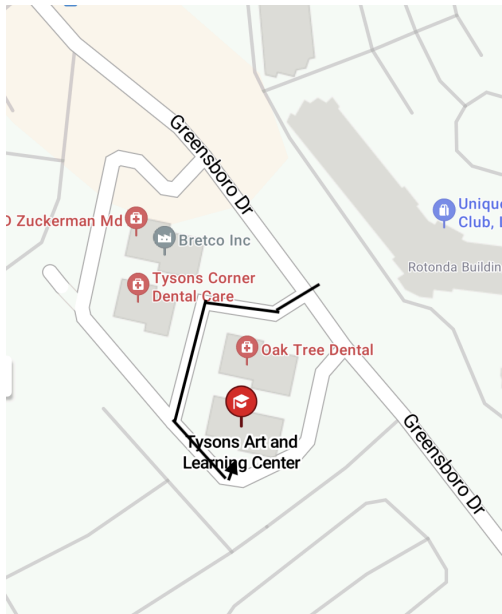

CAMP POLICY AND PROCEDURE

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS IN THE PARKING LOT

Please be advised that there is a blind spot when approaching our building. We kindly request that all parents reduce their speed while in the parking lot to ensure the safety of our students. As children are often present in this area, they must always be accompanied by an adult.

Furthermore, we encourage all parents/guardians to leave the parking lot promptly after pick-up and drop-off. This measure is essential to minimize the risks associated with children running near vehicles and drivers, for safety for all involved.



There are three entrances to our facility; please use the center entrance.

Drop-Off and Pick-Up

Drop-off and pick-up procedures will occur in front of the studio. We respectfully request that parents and caregivers only enter the studios when absolutely necessary in order to limit group sizes. A teacher will be stationed at the door to greet campers and escort them to their classrooms.

To facilitate a quick and efficient sign-in process, it is not required for parents to sign in during the drop-off. Our teachers will take attendance upon your arrival at the door. However, we do require parents or guardians to sign out campers upon their departure, for which a sign-out sheet will be provided at the front.

DROP OFF:

Drop-off begins at 9:00 am

Afternoon Half Day campers should be dropped off at 12:30 pm

For extended care students, early drop-off starts at 8:00 am

PICK UP:

Pick-up starts at 3:30 pm

Morning Half Day campers have pick-up at 12:00 pm

Afternoon extended care is available until 5:30 pm.

DAILY ITEMS TO BRING:

Lunch, a snack for the morning and afternoon, and a water bottle.

The designated lunch period will be from 12:00 pm to 12:30 pm

Half-day campers do not need to bring lunch.

Electronic devices are only allowed to be used during lunch and snack times.

All campers are required to wear closed-toe shoes and dress appropriately for messy art projects, as the paints we use may stain clothing. We will provide art smocks to protect the clothing, but we recommend wearing clothes that you don't mind getting dirty.

We ask that you label all personal items with your camper's name to avoid any confusion or mix-ups.

Please note that we are not responsible for any lost or stolen items, so it's essential to keep track of personal belongings.

For campers who are signed up for extended care, we recommend bringing books or electronic devices if they prefer.

We are a tree-nut and peanut-free facility to ensure the safety of campers with allergies.

SPECIAL NEEDS

If there are any special considerations we should know about concerning your child (such as medications, allergies, behavioral issues, or illnesses), please inform our teachers and the office if these were not noted during registration.

CANCELLATION

15 or more days prior to the camp session starting date: A Full Refund minus a \$25 Processing Fee

14 days or less prior to the camp session starting date: A 50% refund will be issued

7 days or less prior to the camp session starting date: No Refund will be given

We understand that campers may fall ill, but please note that there are no make-up days, credits, or prorated amounts for any days or weeks missed in your registered camps

.BEHAVIOR GUIDELINES

Tyson's Art and Learning Center, Inc. reserves the absolute right to dismiss a camper without refund for any behavior (1) that threatens or endangers the welfare and/or the safety of any camper, instructor, or any other person involved with the camp, (2) is disruptive to the overall camp environment, which interferes with the beneficial use and enjoyment by campers and staff, or (3) for any form of bullying of other campers or disrespectful behavior to camp authority.

Tyson's Art and Learning Center, Inc. emphasizes a safe, fun, and healthy camp environment that fosters learning and friendship, and appropriate camp behavior is essential to a great overall experience for everyone involved. It is imperative that every camper feels included, safe, and part of our camp community.

We expect campers to follow the established code of conduct expressed to campers by our teachers on the first day.

Any behavior showing disrespect or disobedience to these guidelines will not be tolerated. The teacher will address initial behavior problems, but the camp director will be notified if negative behavior continues. Parents will receive the first phone call after the camp director speaks with the camper.

We will contact you if your child is unwilling to change his/her behavior, shows a pattern of disobedience, exhibits violent or disruptive behavior, or is assaulting other campers (physically or verbally).

Campers who assault other campers will be dismissed from camp programs immediately.

We appreciate your cooperation in ensuring a safe and respectful environment for all campers.
